The Williamston Schools Foundation (the "Foundation") Grant Committee will meet and review all Grant Applications. Grant Applications that do not meet the criteria will be disqualified. The Grant Committee will evaluate all proposals in accordance with the Foundation's Grant Criteria. Each individual member of the Grant Committee will evaluate each Grant Application using this Score Card. The scores given by each individual committee member for each Grant Application will be totaled for the Grant Committee as a whole. All Grant Applications will be ranked from the highest total points to the lowest total points; with the award of grants based upon such ranking. Grant applications that are disqualified by the Grant Committee will not be scored; however, the Grant Committee members will note the reason for disqualification on the Score Card.
